



Boarding Policy and Admission Form

1. All Distemper, Parvovirus, Respiratory and Rabies vaccinations must be current. All cats must be FELV/FIV tested prior to board. All animals must have a negative fecal test result on record within 6 months from the first day of boarding.
2. One of the advantages of boarding your pet in a veterinary hospital is that veterinary attention is readily available should the need arise. If your pet becomes ill, we will call the emergency number(s) listed regarding your pet's signs, treatment options, and an estimate of additional costs. If no one can be reached, however, please indicate your wishes below should your pet require treatment to relieve immediate discomfort or to resolve a medical condition.

_____ Please perform whatever services the doctors of Animal Health Care deem necessary for the best care of my pet until someone can be reached.

_____ Do NOT administer anything but emergency medical care until someone can be reached.

3. Pets can be admitted and discharged after 9 am Monday through Sunday.
4. If you are unable to pick up your pet on the planned day, please call so that we can make the necessary arrangements.
